Minutes of DDC Meeting for the month of October/2021

The meeting was presided over by Smti. Kavitha Padmanabhan, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Nagaon and assisted by Sri Hemanta Bhuyan, ACS, District Development Commissioner, Nagaon.

Initiating the discussion, the Deputy Commissioner, Nagaon welcomed all to the DDC meeting.
