The meeting of the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Nagaon was held on 17th August, 2026 at 03:00 PM in the Conference Hall of the Office of the District Commissioner, Nagaon under the chairmanship of Sri Devasish Sharma, IAS, District Commissioner & Chairperson, DDMA, Nagaon.

At the outset, Sri Dipankar Barman, ACS, Additional District Commissioner & Chief Executive Officer, DDMA, Nagaon briefed the Chair on the objectives of the meeting and made a presentation highlighting the damages caused by flood, storm, fire, lightning and erosion during 2026, together with the initiatives and activities undertaken by DDMA, Nagaon.

Thereafter, HoD of the Water Resources Department, APDCL, Irrigation, Fisheries and Agriculture Departments made presentations on their respective CLTF/SDRF/SDMF proposals. The Kaliabor, Samaguri, Rupahi, Nagaon-Sadar and Kampur Revenue Circles also placed their respective Rehabilitation Grant (RG) proposals before the Authority for consideration.

The District Commissioner reviewed the ongoing flood preparedness, response and mitigation activities and the proposals submitted by the concerned line departments and Revenue Circles. After detailed deliberation, the following matters were considered and decisions were taken:

**1. Requirement of Chain Saws at Kaliabor**

The CDC, Kaliabor Co-District informed the Authority that two (2) Nos. of chain saws are required for clearance and emergency response in view of recurring landslides in the Bhurapahar area. It was informed that only one (1) chain saw is presently available. The meeting decided that a proposal for procurement/provision of the additional chain saws will be submitted to ASDMA.

**Action:** DDMA.

**2. Deployment of Additional Inflatable Rubber Boat (IRB)**

The CDC, Kaliabor Co-District requested for one (1) additional Inflatable Rubber Boat (IRB) under the jurisdiction of Kaliabor Co-District for effective flood rescue and emergency response. The Sr. Station In-Charge, Fire & Emergency Services, Nagaon was requested to make necessary arrangements for deployment of one additional IRB at Kaliabor Revenue Circle.

**Action:** Sr. Station In-Charge, F&ES, Nagaon.

**3. Coordination with Misa Army Camp**

The Circle Officer, Kaliabor Revenue Circle requested advance coordination and cooperation of the Flood Rescue Team of Misa Army Camp for prompt rescue operations, considering the proximity of the Army Camp to

Kaliabor Co-District. The meeting decided that a coordination meeting with Misa Army may be convened immediately.

**Action:** DDMA/ Circle Officer, Kaliabor Revenue Circle.

#### 4. Satellite Phone at Diyu Tea Garden

The Circle Officer, Kaliabor Revenue Circle informed that Diyu Tea Garden and adjoining areas fall within a mobile network shadow zone and require reliable communication during emergencies. It was decided that the satellite phone already allotted for Kaliabor Revenue Circle, may use it at Diyu Tea Garden area as and when required.

**Action:** Circle Officer, Kaliabor Revenue Circle.

#### 5. Waterlogging and Flood Mitigation Measures

The District Commissioner observed that at certain locations under Samaguri Revenue Circle, localised culverts are obstructing the natural flow of water, resulting in waterlogging and flooding in nearby areas. The Circle Officer, Samaguri Revenue Circle was directed to inspect the affected locations, identify the obstructed culverts and take necessary steps for restoration of the natural flow of water.

The feasibility of riverbank/embankment protection along the Kolong River under the jurisdiction of Samaguri Revenue Circle shall also be examined. The Water Resources Department and Panchayat & Rural Development Department were requested to jointly assess the feasibility in coordination with the Circle Officer, Samaguri Revenue Circle and take necessary follow-up action.

#### 6. Removal of Water Hyacinth and Accumulated Debris

It was apprised that, on receipt of reports from the Circle Officers of Samaguri, Nagaon-Sadar and Rupahi Revenue Circles, DDMA undertook removal of water hyacinth and accumulated debris at identified locations. The concerned Circle Officers shall submit the bills along with detailed reports and geotagged photographs after completion of the works, in accordance with the applicable norms of assistance under SDRF/NDRF.

The initiative was appreciated by the local people and the Authority noted that such measures contribute to improving water flow, reducing waterlogging and maintaining a cleaner environment.

#### 7. Review and Approval of CLTF Proposals

The CLTF proposals submitted by the concerned line departments and Revenue Circles were placed before the District Disaster Management Authority for review and consideration. The proposals were examined and discussed in detail by the members present. After due deliberation, the Authority accorded in-principal approval to the proposals, subject to fulfilment of all prescribed criteria, documentation and applicable norms. The proposal-wise details are placed below.

**7.8 SDMF Mitigation Scheme – FY 2026-27**

The meeting, after due deliberation, decided to approve the proposal for “Integrated Irrigation Scheme for Mitigation of Drought-like Situation at Kaliabor LAC under SDMF for the year 2025-26”, submitted by the Executive Engineer, Kaliabor-Samaguri Division (Irrigation), Jakhalabandha, with the objective of mitigating the seasonal drought-like situation in the Kaliabor LAC.

The proposal, initially prepared for an estimated amount of Rs. 600.00 Lakhs, was subsequently enhanced to Rs. 900.00 Lakhs as per Govt. direction vide CE Letter No. DMC/SDMF/IRRIG/2022-23/159 dated 03/02/2026.

The Integrated Irrigation Scheme is specifically configured to conserve, store and utilize available surface/Ground water during dry periods and mitigate the adverse effects of seasonal drought-like conditions in the Kaliabor LAC.

The meeting approved the proposal for an amount of Rs. 900.00 Lakhs, subject to observance of all prescribed departmental procedures.

### 7.9 Re-verified Proposal submitted by DAO & DFDO, Nagaon

In continuation of the minutes of the meeting held on 26th September, 2025, particularly Agenda Item No. 7, the DAO & DFDO, Nagaon placed the re-verified proposal before the Authority. The meeting approved the proposal as placed at Annexure-III. The DAO & DFDO, Nagaon shall ensure uploading of the beneficiary details in the Damage Assessment Portal after sanction, as per applicable procedure.

### 8. Flood Damage Assessment and Submission of Proposals

The Chair directed all concerned officers to complete the assessment of damages caused by the prevailing flood and submit proposals for consideration in the CLTF meeting, along with the complete list of beneficiaries in the prescribed format, on or before 30th August, 2026.
