


SUCCESS STORY
Pachim Nagaon Water Harvesting and Distribution Project
RIDF-XIX for 2013-14
Under Nagaon Soil Conservation Division, Nagaon.

1. **Name of project**:- Pachim Nagaon Water Harvesting and Distribution Project under RIDF-XIX for 2013-14.
2. **Location**:- The project site is situated at Pachim Nagaon village under Mayong Development Block and Jagirod G.P. of Morigaon District.
3. **Pre project condition/problem**:- The 2 (two) numbers perennial channels namely Sapna and Majika originated from Sonaikuchi reserved forest flows through the paddy field and covers a large area of project site. After crossing railway line through low laying areas of the paddy land and finally meets Era-Kolong river. As sufficient water does not retain in field, cultivators face difficulty to go for cultivator in their areas. Single cropping i.e. Sali Paddy have been practised by the farmers depending upon monsoon rain only. No double cropping in the project area have been possible in pre-project condition.
4. **Post Project benefit**:-
 - i. The moisture content in retaining rain water of the area has increased,
 - ii. The loss of top fertile soil has stopped marginally.
 - iii. Double cropping have been practiced by the farmers after completion of the project thus production has increased and has gone upto 3000 Kg/Ha. Where it was only 1000 Kg/Ha. As reported by the local farmers.
 - iv. The living standard of farmers increases.
5. **Number of farmers benefitted**:- 575 Nos. farmer families have been benefitted from the project.
6. **Area developed in Hector**:- 890 Ha.
